## Summary of School Improvement Priorities 2020

**OUR PURPOSE:** Our purpose is to provide authentic and relevant opportunities for all students to achieve their potential.

**OUR VISION:** Cairns State Special School is an outward facing school, a vibrant place, a learning place and an innovative place. We nurture purposeful community links that provide personalised and relevant opportunities for all students to reach their potential and have a voice and choice in their learning and pathway.

### **OUR PRIORITIES:**

**Refining our Curriculum Framework and data collection processes for all learning areas mindful of access to learning for our multi-sensory learners:**

- Implement the *Australian Curriculum* providing contexts for learning in all learning areas (English, Maths, Science, Humanities and Social Sciences, Technologies, Health and Physical Education, The Arts, Languages, Work Studies) for all students in Years P-10 and the *Guideline for Individual Learning (GIL)* in Yrs. 11-12.
- Refine *data collection processes* for all learning areas ensuring data is collected for all reportable student goals.

**Documenting and sharing the work of our Professional Learning Teams:**

- Teams of teachers contribute to the production of an electronic *Professional Portfolio of Practice* that details their learning in relation to *high impact teaching strategies* within a selected learning context, for sharing and feedback.

**Collaboratively formulate the Student Code of Conduct:**

- Jointly develop the new *Student Code of Conduct* with staff and community, and endorse through the Local Consultative Committee, P&C and School Council. Share with all stakeholders.

**Supporting community partnerships that enhance student learning outcomes.**

- Explore and formalise *community partnerships* that can contribute positively to enhancing student learning outcomes.
